

Pupil Premium Funding

The Pupil Premium is a sum of money given to schools each year by the Government to improve the attainment of children who are eligible for Free School Meals. The school uses this money to ensure that children receive extra support and access to resources should they need it. The school reports each year on its website how the Pupil Premium Grant is spent.



By checking to see if your child is eligible for the funding you are really helping the school to fund extra support, trips, visits and experiences for our children. It also means your child may be eligible for Free School Meals when they enter Year 3. You only have to set up an account once then you can login again.
