this is a communication app that we use to send letters and information and texts to you if you download the app this goes straight to your phone and you are notified. You may even be reading this newsletter on the app!

The recent school closure has shown us how important it is for us to be able to keep in touch with you and send information out in this

way so please do download and login to both apps.

## **Remote Learning**

The children have all been issued with their remote learning packs today. They are in a large white envelope and all of the paperwork is printed on yellow paper. It is really important that you read these and keep these safe in case we have to close a class, the whole school or if your family have to isolate.

The letter in the pack gives you full details and the user guide for Microsoft Teams is very useful. Some of the teachers have already set the children some tasks using this platform.

The remote learning pages of the school website will have lots of information on that will be really useful for you to have a good look through.

If you do not have access to a suitable device (laptop or tablet) or an internet connection then you will need to inform the school of this when your child is told to isolate. We will then try to support you with this.

It will be an expectation that children fully access ALL remote learning whilst isolating at home.

## **Annual Flu Vaccination**

You should have received a letter regarding how to consent for your child to receive this year's flu vaccination. This vaccination is recommended to help protect your child against flu. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu. The vaccination date allocated to our school is Thursday 19th November . You will need to enter the following code to ensure the completed form can be correctly allocated to your child's school: EE145489

The vaccination is free and is a quick and simple spray up the nose. This vaccine is a yearly vaccine. All vaccinated children will be given a sticker or an ink stamp on their hand. If you have any queries please contact the School Aged Immunisation Service on 01522 572950.

The NHS team do not send out reminders to parents so you do need to register your children now if you want them immunised this term.
