We host Family Learning sessions, each class has a class assembly, all children perform at Christmas at least once which parents are invited to, we invite parents from year group to lunch once a year, we hold Sports Day in the summer term, we have open afternoons at least twice a year, we have invested in MarvellousMe! app parents can 'Hi5' to show interaction with school and their child's specific learning and achievements. Of course we will look into other manageable ways of interacting with our parents.

More school trips

We like to go on as many trips as possible. We are a 'Beach School' so children get to visit the beach at least three times a year although this is not a trip of great distance our research in school shows very few children get the opportunity to visit the beach in their time away from school. We organise a two-night residential each year for the y5/6 children. Our location does make the distance to travel on trips a long way and does mean a long day and travel costs can be high but we direct Pupil Premium funding towards this but we still rely on parental contributions to make trips viable. We have a variety of visitors in to school (Mobile Planetarium, Ancient Greek workshops, Climbing Wall, Author visits). Now we know parents would like more trips and are prepared to support with payment this is definitely something we will look into.
