Transition - September 2020

The teachers are currently putting some information together for their new classes. Normally we would have held a 'move up' session with the children and their new teachers but this will not be possible this year. We will send out the transition information to each year group before the end of term. As we are a relatively small school and have a settled team of staff (all of the teachers have stayed in the same year group from this school year to next) the children will recognise their new teacher and will get to know more about them and their routines in the transition pack. There will also be lots of time in September spent for everyone 'to get to know each other'.

Work Packs

We have put together some paper based work packs for Year 1 to 5 and children who are not currently in school (those children in school will be given theirs). They are on the railings at the front of the school. Each pack is named and the packs are organised in year groups. If you haven't already - please come to collect your child's pack.

Free School Meals

We want to make sure as many eligible pupils as possible are claiming their free school meals, and we want to make it as easy as possible for parents.

Free school meals offer a healthy, wide selection of options for your child at lunch time and can save families approximately £460 per year. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and already has school meals, check to see if your child will continue to receive free school meals when they are older by applying.

If you are unsure as to whether your child is eligible then you should apply anyway- this way you can ensure that your child is not missing out!
